

WE CAN MAKE CALIFORNIA SAFE FOR BUSINESS AGAIN!

California's small businesses have been hit hard by ill-considered and oppressive laws and regulations—especially over the past five years. Arnold Schwarzenegger's election in the recall of Gov. Gray Davis signals the turning point of the anti-business atmosphere that has driven companies, jobs, and tax revenue out of California.

Small businesses have a unique opportunity to join mid-sized and large businesses to help advance the cause of changing the business climate. This November citizens will consider two measures that will, when properly disposed of, go a long way to achieving this goal.

The first, Proposition 64, reforms the Unfair Competition Law (Business & Professions Code §17200), the overly-broad law that permitted the Trevor Law Group's legal campaign to extort undeserved "settlements" from over 2,000 auto repair dealers and hundreds of restaurants in Southern California in 2002. The second, Proposition 72, is a referendum on SB 2 (Burton), passed in the last weeks before the recall and signed by Gov. Davis. SB 2 requires employers with 20 or more employees to provide health insurance for their employees or pay a huge tax to fund a massive bureaucracy that would provide the coverage.
